Benchmark: Five-year average credential examination (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography Exam) pass rate of not less than 75% at first attempt within six months of graduation.

Benchmark: Five-year average job placement rate of not less than 75% within twelve months of graduation.

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* **Job Placement Rate (JPR)** - is defined as the number of graduates employed in radiography, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, or medical dosimetry within twelve months of graduation compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences. The JRCERT has defined "not actively seeking employment" as:

- 1) Graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts **OR**
- 2) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation **OR**
- 3) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours **OR**
- 4) Graduate is on active military duty **OR**
- 5) Graduate is continuing education.

Program completion rate is defined as the number of students who complete the program within 150% of the stated program length. Program length is 24 months and program completion rate is calculated as those students graduating within 36 months of beginning the program. Program benchmark = 75%.
