***ADMISSION:** Applications for the RT program will be accepted year round, but should be submitted by the first week in August. The program can accept up to 30 students each calendar year, with a new class beginning in the first week of October. Applications submitted after the first week in August will be considered for the next year's admissions. Admissions interviews are granted to applicants who have submitted all the required documents. Admission Steps	When
Step 1. Submit ALL required application documents	Year-round up to first week in August
Step 2. Applicant interview	As scheduled by program officials
Step 3. Notification of acceptance	When accepted (usually within two weeks of interview).
Step 4. If granted acceptance, reserve seat with payment of a \$1,300 nonrefundable deposit	Due within 30 days of acceptance
Step 5: Submit updated immunizations (for MMR, TDap, Varicella and Hepatitis B)	Due on or before orientation day
Step 6: Attend mandatory orientation	Second Friday in August (9-4:00)
Step 7: Pass background and drug screenings and physical exam	Due first week in September
Step 8: Pay first year tuition of \$4,500	Due by September 15
Step 9: Purchase textbooks, provide proof of health insurance, and document screening for TB	First Monday in October, the first day of classes
Step 10: Complete submission of outstanding pre-requisites for clinical education	Due by October 31

*The program strongly encourages early completion of the application process in order to allow reasonable time for orientation and enrollment.
